

ACTIVE KIDS REBATE

WHAT IS THE ACTIVE KIDS REBATE PROGRAM?

The NSW government will provide a rebate through a voucher system to the parents/guardians of school enrolled children. **The \$100 voucher** can be used for registration and participation costs for sport and fitness activities. The initiative is designed to reduce the barriers to participation and help change the physical activity behaviours of children and young people in NSW.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO CLAIM THE VOUCHER?

Every family in NSW with a child enrolled in school from Kindergarten to year 12 (4.5 to 18 years old) will be eligible for the Active Kids Rebate. It will not be means tested and one voucher will be available for every child in the family annually between 2018 and 2021. There will be no limits on the number of applications per family, as long as every child is enrolled in school.

WHAT CAN THE VOUCHER BE USED FOR?

The voucher can be used for registration or participation fees associated with after-school, weekend sport and structured physical activity programs, that last for 8-10 weeks. The vouchers will be redeemable through approved sport, fitness and physical activity providers upon registration.

WHEN WILL THE PROGRAM BE INTRODUCED?

From 31 January 2018, families will be able to claim their voucher/s online from the Service NSW website
